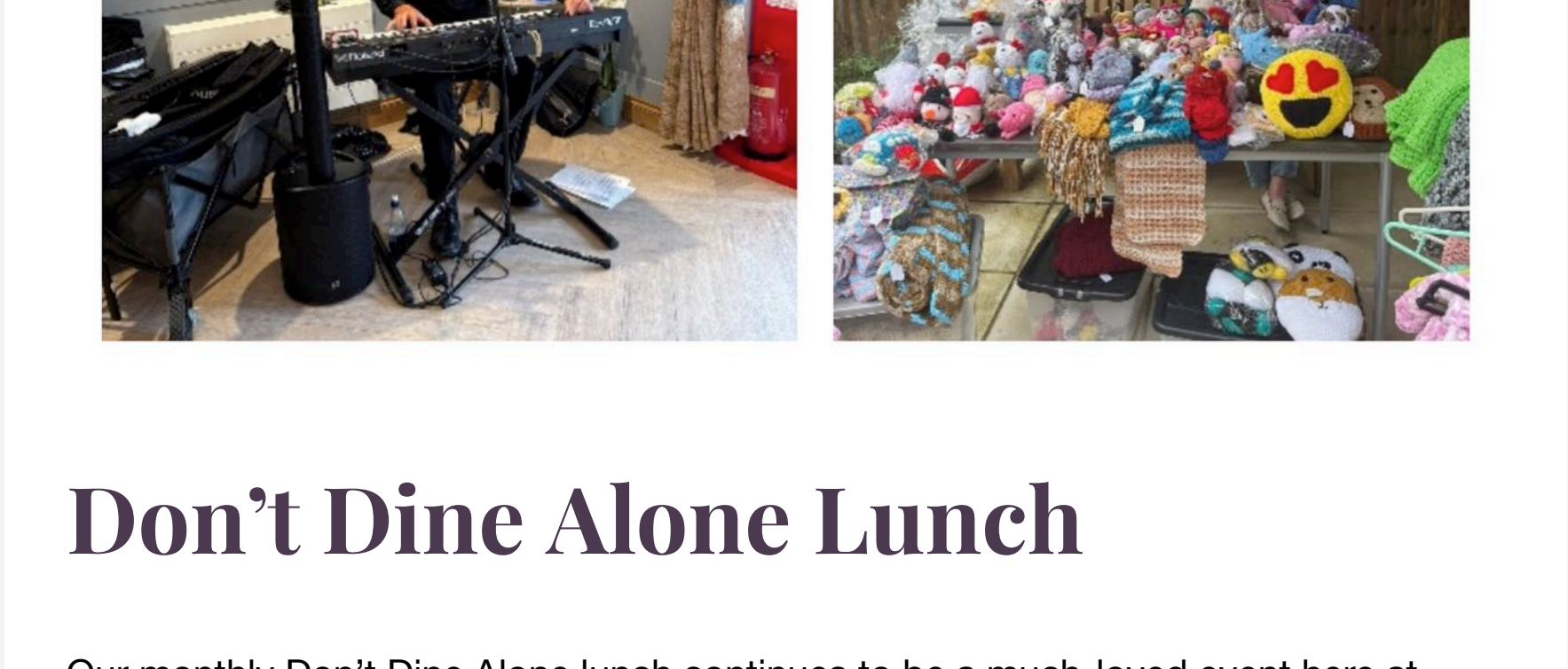
Don't Dine Alone Lunch

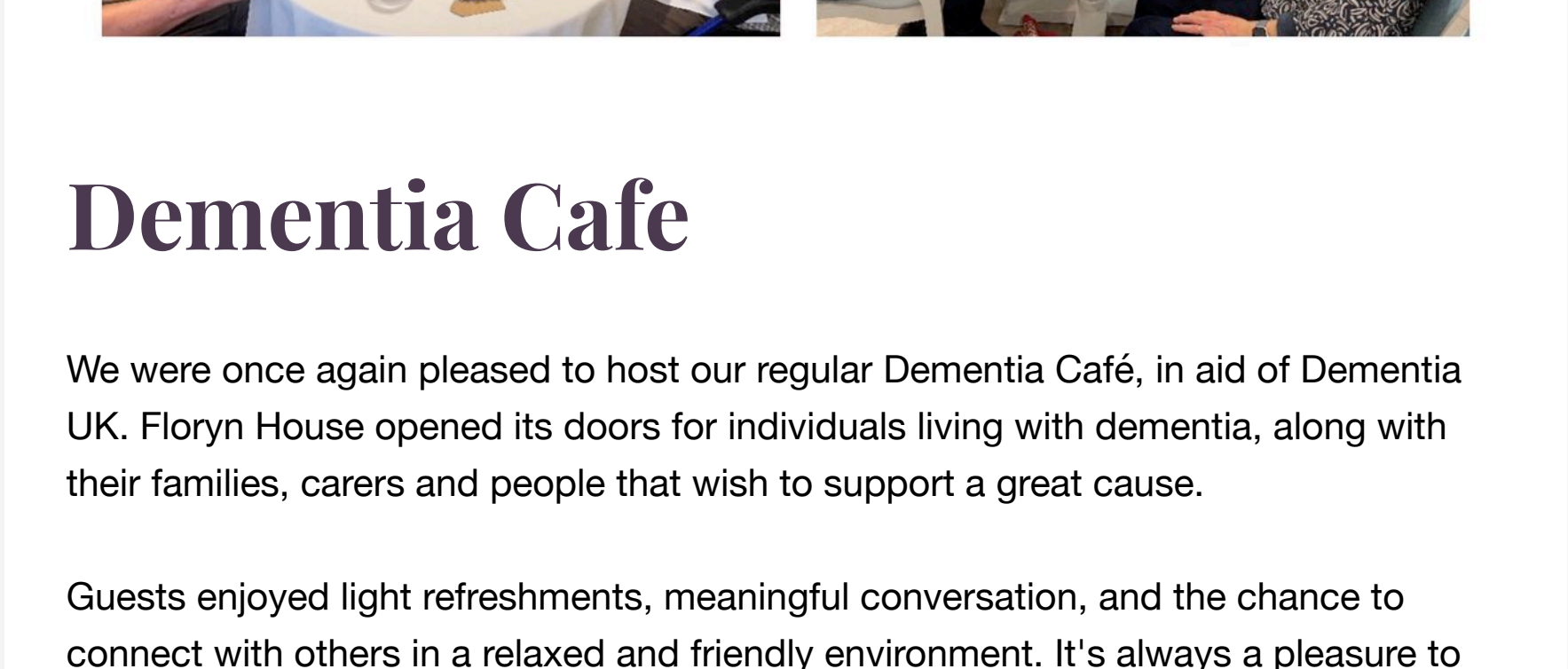

Our next Dementia Café will be held on Friday 24th of October at 11am.



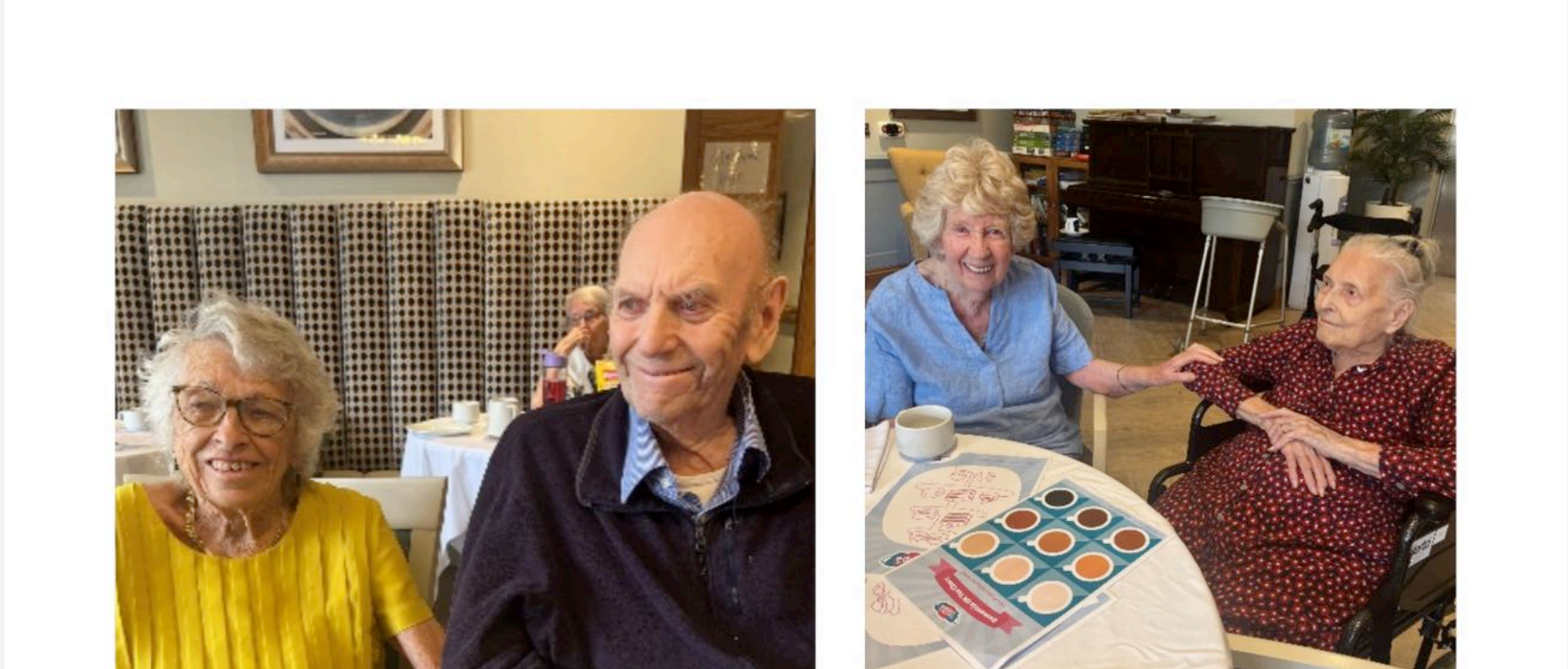
Oktoberfest Celebration

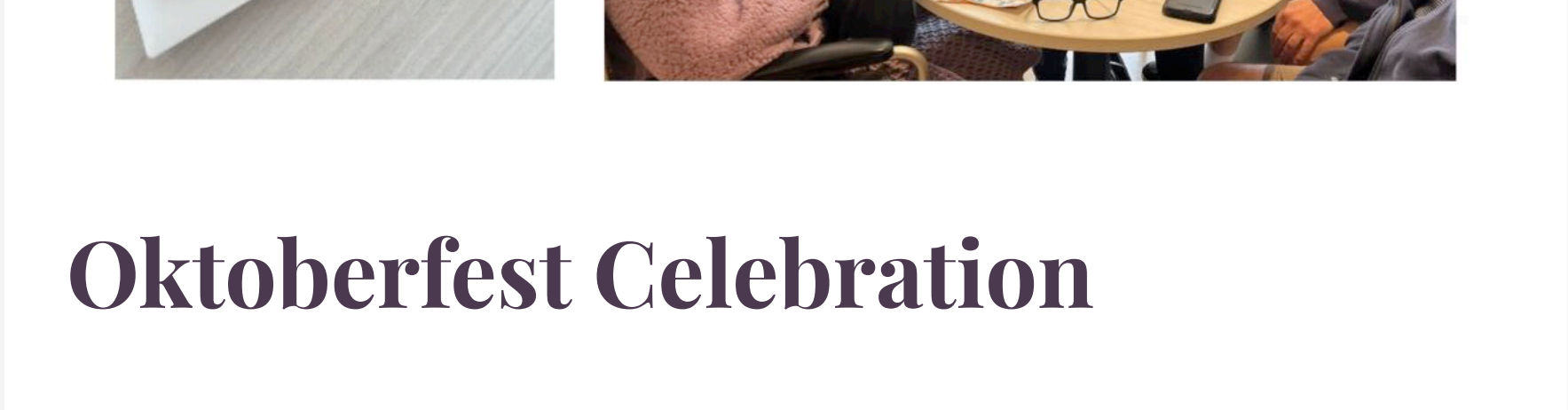
Resident Spotlight

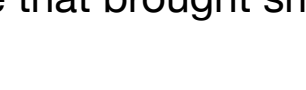
