wonderful way to enjoy quality time together. A big thank you to all who came along.







afternoon. Our residents played an active role in the event, enjoying conversations with guests and lending a hand with preparations and stalls.









We look forward to seeing you at the next lunch on Friday 14th November at 12.30pm!






