FESTIVE CELEBRATIONS

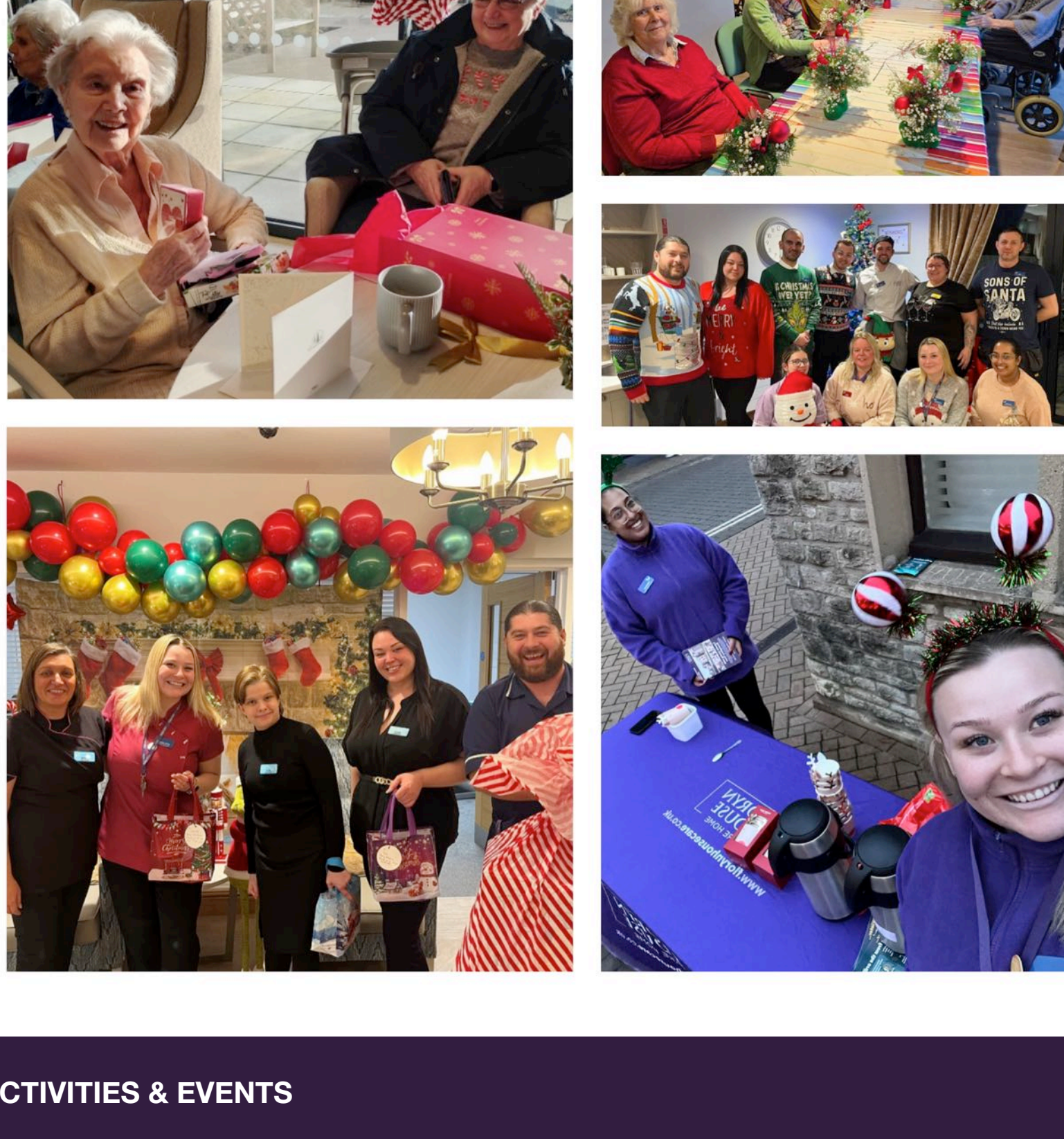
Christmas Celebrations

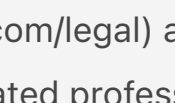

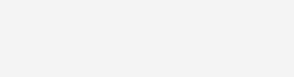
